To: All Charter Steel Customers:

Charter Steel is a major recycler of scrap steel utilizing Electronic Arc Furnace (EAF) technology at its steel recycling facilities. Charter Steel utilizes primary scrap steel feedstock in the production of carbon steel bar, rod and wire products.

Products produced by Charter Steel contain at least 85% recycled content. On average 35% of this can be defined as Post-Consumer recycled content. The remaining 65% of recycled material can be defined as Post-Industrial recycled content. All scrap is purchased within 300 miles of our melt facilities in WI and OH.
